

### 07:15 AM-Triveni Sangam

(Recommended Duration: -45 minutes Triveni Sangam is the convergence point of the holy rivers Ganga, Yamuna, and Saraswati. It is also the venue for the Kumbh Mela, one of the world's biggest festivals and undisputedly the biggest congregation of faith. It is said that taking a dip in the holy water gets one purged of sins and the cycle of re-birth.

# 9:15 A M Akshayavata corridor

(Recommended Durations 30 minutes)

Allahabad Fort was built by the Mughal emperor Akbar at Prayagraj in 1583. The fort stands on the banks of the Yamuna, near its confluence with the Ganges. It has been classified by the Archaeological Survey of India as a monument of national importance.



Akshayavata, also rendered Akshayavat, is a sacred fig tree mentioned in the Hindu classical texts. It is also the name of a sacred lake mentioned in the Purans.

## 10:00 A M Bade Hanuman Darshan

(Recommended Duration: -30 minutes)

The Temple houses a 20 feet idol of Lord Hanuman in a reclining posture in the basement. This unique temple holds the distinction of being the only temple in the world where Lord

Hanuman is worshiped while lying down. The river water floods the basement and bathes the idol during high tides.



### 11:00 AM Bharadwaj Ashram

(Recommended time approx. 30 minutes.)
This place is devoted to Rishi Bhardwaj who is said to have prayed to Lord Shiva here to contain and obstruct the flow of river Ganga to avert the

possible destruction on earth.

#### 11:15 A M Chandrashekhar Azad Park

(Recommended time approx. 15 minutes.)
Constructed in 1870, this grand park was also called the Alfred Park or the Company Bagh during the East India Company's rule. In 1931, the park was renamed Chandrashekhar Azad Park to
