Ayodhya

Settled on banks of river Saryu, Ayodhya is the birthplace of Lord Ram, mentioned as one of the most sacred places in Skanda Puran a classical text. Ayodhya's relevance has been intrinsic in Ramayana another ancient classical text which depicts the story of Lord Ram's life and his 14 years in exile (Vanvas) with Mother Sita and his brother Lord Laxman.



Ram Ki Paidi

11:30 A M - Ram Ki Paidi - (Recommended time approx. 30 Minutes) Reflecting tranquility, Ram Ki Paidi is a sequence of Ghats along the banks of river Saryu. The location has a special place in the hearts of the devotees of Lord Ram who take a holy dip here and seek blessings from the king of Ayodhya.

12:00 PM - HANUMAN GARHI

(Recommended time approx. 30 Minutes) As the name suggests, Hanuman Garhi is a 10th century temple dedicated to Lord Hanuman. After Lord Ram returned from Ayodhya after 14 years in exile (Vanvas), Lord Hanuman started staying here and the place was called Hanuman Garhi. There is a belief that Lord Hanuman sits at Hanuman Garhi to protect the land of Ram. The temple has an extremely positive vibe and attracts devotees the deity from farthest corners of the country.



12:30 PM - DARSHAN SHREE RAM MANDIR

(Recommended time approx. 02 hr.)

Shree Ram Janm Bhoomi temple is one of the most celebrated temples in the country. The statue of Lord Ram here has been carved out of a very ancient black rock depicting him as a five year-old fondly called 'Ram Lalla' a child. Built in the Nagar style of architecture, the premise has dedicated temples of Lord Surya, Goddess Bhagwati, Lord Ganesh, and Lord Shiva.



04.00 P. M. - KANAK BHAWAN

(Recommended time approx. 30 Minutes)

Kanak Bhawan often referred to as the 'Golden Palace', was gifted to Mother Sita and Lord Ram by queen Kaikeyi soon after their wedding. Kanak Bhawan was reconstructed in the 19th century by Vrishbhanu Kuvari, the queen of Orchha, reflecting the continued tradition of royal patronage towards this sacred site.
